Kebbi State House of Assembly Passes the Child Rights Bill

The passage of the bill by the legislative arm of the government in Kebbi state is a necessary and commendable step made towards the final domestication of the international convention of the right of children which was passed into law as the Child Right Act in 2003 by the Federal Government. The passage of the bill into law in Kebbi state represents the desires of the lawmakers to strengthen laws in Kebbi state for the benefit of children in the state, especially girls.
